The cost of the weekend is \$95 per adult, which includes Friday and Saturday night camping (no hookups/dry camping), dinner and entertainment Friday and Saturday nights, and breakfast on Saturday and Sunday mornings. *The reservation deadline is March 7, 2019*. If you are unable to camp but would like to come out for some festivities, we welcome you to visit us on a daily basis; extra meal tickets will be available for purchase for breakfasts and dinners for those of you who do.

Thursday night camping at Live Oak will be available for an additional fee of \$40 *per rig*, no matter the number of campers. The Craft Fair will be held on Saturday from 10-11:30AM in the Pavilion. You must be a registered camper to participate. No commercial craft enterprises, please! We have limited tables for your use; please bring your own if you're able.

**Dogs are** <u>not</u> **allowed in the Pavilion area.** Pets must be leashed 10-feet or shorter and cleaned up after! The California Department of Fish and Game has placed the Santa Ynez River *off limits*. Leave ATVs and gas powered cycles, etc., at home; only authorized persons are allowed to use them.

Toilet and shower facilities near the Pavilion, as well as remote port-a-potties, are available for your use.
