#### FROM THE DESK OF THE LODGE SECRETARY

I'll keep this short and sweet since I only have 2 things to touch on. First: the members that are still delinquent have until Monday, Feb 9<sup>th</sup> as the FINAL pay-by date for your *total* past dues for the 2014-15 year. If you have not paid your dues for 2014-15 I will have to drop you from our membership roster and you will receive a letter stating that you have been dropped. You will then have 30 days to appeal your dropped status with no penalty by paying your total past dues amount and by a <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> vote on the floor of our March 19<sup>th</sup> meeting. After 30 days, you will have to pay your total past dues amount *and* the penalty of \$37.50, and your name will be brought to the floor where a <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> vote will reinstate your membership. Statements for the 2015-16 year have gone out and a few of you have already turned in your dues. BIG GOLD STARS for you!!! You can pay your dues at the bar by cash, check or credit card whenever we're open (2-7PM every day).

Second: Jamboree meetings will start on Sunday, Feb 8<sup>th</sup> at 1 PM, and continue weekly until the event April 23-26. If you are interested in helping out, please let me know or show up to the meeting to find out what you can do to make this event a success!!

## WHY SUPPORT THE ELKS NATIONAL FOUNDATION (ENF)

Each year the Grand Exalted Ruler sets a per capita goal for each lodge to contribute to ENF; this year was \$4.60 per member. With your generous contributions the members of the Santa Ynez Valley Elks have (to date) contributed over \$3,500, which averages to \$13.44 per person. That puts us at #7 in the nation for lodges under 300 members, and #82 overall—can we make #1 by year-end? Consider making a donation before April 1<sup>st</sup> to put us over the top!

One might wonder what the money is used for. I'm glad you asked! At its meeting in Tampa on February 12, 2014, the ENF Board of Trustees approved appropriations and distributions for the 2014-15 fiscal year totaling a record **\$26.5 million**, split up as follows:

During the 2013-14 Elks year, the members in California-Hawaii donated \$802,677.63 to the Elks National Foundation. This year, the Foundation will give back to us the following:

That's a return of 1.980 for every dollar the Foundation received from our state association last year. And that doesn't even include the money lodges in our state will get back through our <u>Community Investments Program</u>. For the 2012-13 fiscal year, for example, a total of \$362,990 was awarded to 120 California-Hawaii Lodges.

This year the Santa Ynez Valley Elks Lodge received a total of \$4,000 through grants to help fund two of our programs: Our continued support to help Veterans and active service members through "SYV Support the Troops," and our program at Christmas time to help support families with children undergoing cancer treatment. As you can see, your donations to ENF come all the way back to your own Lodge and community, and we actually receive more money than we donate.

You should have received your 2015-16 annual dues statement from the Lodge; please consider adding a donation for ENF so that our Lodge, and all the others, can continue to receive benefits from this great program.
