Our Lodge will host our DDGER on Thursday, October 1st. The visitation and inspection with officers will be followed by dinner and a meeting. We'd love to see you all there! Here's Jim's official biography:

James was born in Santa Paula, California in 1952. He lived there with his mother and grandparents while his father was in the Korean conflict. After serving in Korea his father returned and the family moved to Ventura until 1962 when they moved back to Santa Paula. James graduated from Santa Paula High and began a Dental Technician apprenticeship, which was a fiveyear term with a promise of 50% ownership in the business. He was married that year and in 1972 his daughter Tisa was born. At one year of age she was diagnosed with a congenital defect that was life threatening. She needed two operations at a cost comparable to what two houses would have cost at that time. An organization like the Elks (The Crippled Children's Fund) stepped in and paid for the operations which saved her life, and at the age of 40 she now has two of her own children. James moved his family to Santa Barbara in 1979. He has raised four children with his wife Anne, has six grandchildren and still runs his own dental laboratory.

James is thankful to be part of an organization that helps children through its Major Projects Program and helps the communities that surround their lodges through State and National programs. He was initiated in 2002 and immediately became the Lodge Chaplain. Moving through all the chairs he became Exalted Ruler of Santa Barbara Lodge #613 in 2009-2010. James also served the district as the Drug Awareness chairman and then as the ENF chairman. In 2013-2014 he served as the West Central Coast District's Association Vice President.

As the Grand Exalted Ruler's Deputy James is honored that he has a chance to help the West Central Coast District to continue to lead the Elks organization in charitable contributions and to provide leadership and guidance to our 12 very special and unique lodges.
